Executive Director, West Bengal AYUSH Samity till attaining the 65 years of age for the following posts. A panel will be prepared; validity of the panel will be for one year from the date of appointment.

## SOP for AYUSH Telemedicine unit (HUB) to be Operational at each district attached to DMO Office

- 1. Telemedicine Service has become an effective mode to reach out to the public.
- 2. The Nodal Officer in charge of this service will be DMO (AYUSH) and the mobile phones dedicated to AYUSH Telemedicine Service will be kept in the custody of DMO (AYUSH) Office.
- 3. Two (SIM) with premier numbers which are easy to remember and dedicated for the purpose can be used for this Telemedicine Services.
- 4. The doctors will do counseling on various health related issues ranging from basic medical advice, influenza like illness, Post COVID complaints, lifestyle disorders and various other issues which is locally relevant as per the need of the public and the district. They shall also guide people regarding the availability of the AYUSH services in the District.
- 5. Follow up of the patients Patients consulted through telemedicine shall be referred to their (patient's) nearest AYUSH dispensaries for follow up.
- 6. Timings- 10.00 am to 3.00 pm five days in a week
- 7. Monitoring and Evaluation shall be done by DMO AYUSH of respective district as the Nodal Officer in charge of Telemedicine service will be DMO (AYUSH) and the mobile phones dedicated to AYUSH Telemedicine Service will be kept in the custody of DMO (AYUSH) Office.
- 8. Reports shall be uploaded online and monitored by the State Hqrs and SPMU, NAM, WBAS.
- 9. The Telephone numbers can be made popular with the help of District Information Officer who can play a vital role in disseminating this service to the masses.
- 10. Attractive IEC materials at various strategic locations of the Districts to be displayed for mass awareness of the Service.
- 11. In various remote areas of Bengal, people speak in their local language like Nepali and Santali. AYUSH telemedicine can be made available in those languages that will help it to gain popularity easily
- 12. Staff of the Telemedicine unit: AYUSH MO(s) on daily honorarium One MTS on daily wages
- 13. Retired HMO/SAMO/UMO till attainment of 65 years having good knowledge of AYUSH system of the district may be deployed. Honorarium@ 1000/- per day may be given for maximum 20 days in a month.
- 14. The Medical Officer shall be assisted by one MTS who shall be appointed by District on daily wage basis. He shall be at least Madhyamik passed (secondary level) and computer literate. A sum of Rs 500/- per day may be given for maximum 20 days in a month.
- 15. A 3 (Three) member Committee comprising of CMOH, DMO(Ayush) and one representative of district magistrate shall select the casual staff as mentioned. CMOH shall be the Chairperson of the Committee.
