SCHEME

Establishment of MRI Scan unit at M.R.Bangur Hospital, the District Hospital of South 24 Parganaa through Public Private Partnership (PPP)

Health and Family Welfare Department, Government of West Bengal February 2014

1. Background

- a) Department of Health & Family Welfare (DoHFW) has identified several important needs and taken initiatives to strengthening the Health and Medical care services for greater benefit of the people in the State. Amongst various needs, access to advance and state of the art diagnostic facilities at affordable cost is one such important initiative that DoHFW has planned to undertake specially at the level of secondary and tertiary care hospitals for the benefit of the population at large.
- b) Along with the above initiatives, with the rapid advancement in the diagnostic field, the DoHFW has also felt the need to upgrade the existing Diagnostic Facilities in some of the important health care level, especially for the Imaging Facilities for initiating better treatment protocol with faster pace for the benefit of both the Doctors and Patients. Keeping this in mind, the DoHFW now wishes to engage a competent organization under Public Private Partnership (PPP) for establishment and round the clock operation of 1.5 Tesla MRI scan unit at the M.R.Bangur Hospital, the District Hospital of South 24 Parganas, Tollygunge, Kolkata-700033 for the benefit of the patients of the concerned hospital as well for other hospitals in this District
- c) The purpose of this initiative under PPP is to engage competent organization in this field selected through Expression of Interest (EoI) with defined criteria and transparent process of selection and utilize their strengths to bring in operational efficiencies of the private partner for **round the clock operation** of the MRI facility in this institute. The objective of round the clock operation is to cope with the need for MRI scan to the patients of the hospital as well as patients referred from other hospitals at any point time,
- d) Salient features of the scheme and other relevant information for establishment of the MRI services are provided in the following sections

2. Description of the Scheme

a. Partnership Model

- The partnership would be governed by an agreement with detailed terms and conditions to be signed by the selected Private Sector Partner (PSP) with the Director, M.R.BANGUR HOSPITAL for installation, establishment and running of the 1.5 Tesla MRI scan unit round the clock.
- 2) The initial duration of the agreement will be for a period of four years. There will be an annual review of performance. The renewal of the contract at the end of four years will be subject to satisfactory consecutive annual review reports during the contract period.

b. Salient Points of the Agreement

- 1) Under this agreement, the selected PSP will set up the unit in the allocated space provided by the hospital authorities within the hospital premises
- 2) The PSP shall procure and install the latest 1.5 Tesla MRI scan unit from organization of repute and credible as well as other accessories and equipments for setting up the unit at their own cost in the hospital for operation and management of the services under PPP. The specification of the equipment needs to be submitted by the PSP along with the application for approval of the selection committee during evaluation of the application.
- 3) As per terms of the agreement, the hospital authorities will provide ready-to-use space as per requirement of The West Bengal Clinical Establishment Act 1950 and The West Bengal Clinical Establishment Rules 2003 as amended hereafter. Water supply will also be provided free of cost. The PSP will be required to install separate electric meter as described under Section 3c and pay consumption charges directly to the energy supplier as per prevailing rules of the energy supplier.
- 4) The PSP shall be responsible for the entire operation and management of the unit round the clock through out the year and undertake necessary investigations for all the patients treated in this hospital and collect **payments** from the patients of the government hospital at rates approved by the RKS. The approved rates are provided as **Annexure V**.
- 5) The PSP may also extend the services to patients referred from private practitioners/private hospitals and charge, collect and retain user charges at the market rate. However, it is to be noted that patients of the concerned hospital will get priority at all times for use of these facilities.
- 6) As part of the obligation of the agreement, the selected private partner shall have to pay a concession fee to the Rogi Kalyan Samiti (RKS) of the concerned hospital on quarterly basis in lieu of the space and the access and captive market provided by setting up the centre and thereby the business generated. The Bidding parameter for selection of the PSP shall have both technical components and financial offer. The fixed quarterly amount offered by the applicants by way of financial offer will be the final basis of selection of technically qualified applicants.
- 7) The hospital authorities shall review the amount of concession fee at the end of each year for revision based on performance
- 8) Free services shall be extended to the poor and vulnerable sections of population to cover safety nets for this scheme for such patients. Such free services will be extended up to 20% of the patients eligible for free services in each month out of the total number of patients who have undergone investigation/services in the previous month. The concerned RKS will utilize revenue received by way of concession fees from the PSP for reimbursement of cost for such free services to the concerned PSP on quarterly basis as described under Section 5b.

3. Role and Responsibilities of the Hospital Authorities and its various wings

- a. The required ready to use space as per clinical establishment norms for the MRI services and supply of water (including water tax, if any) will be provided free of cost by the hospital authorities to the PSP for running of the services.
- b. In case ready to use space is not available, the hospital authorities will undertake necessary work to make the space in 'ready to use' condition. However, the PSP will be allowed to make additional painting and refurbishing of the premises if it so desires at its own cost. However, it may be mentioned here that the PSP except with the prior permission in writing from hospital authorities would not carry out any major structural changes or major modifications in the Hospital but shall be entitled to make such minor modifications as may be necessary in its opinion for delivering the standard services, provided, any such modifications are in accordance with the Clinical Establishment Rules.
- c. Use of electricity will be allowed by the hospital authorities for which the PSP will pay consumption charges directly to the energy supplier as per prevailing rules of the energy supplier. Necessary NOC from the competent authority of the concerned hospital will be provided to the PSP for procurement of separate electric meter for which the applicable security deposit and installation charges within the operating rooms under PPP will be borne by the PSP. However, it is to be noted that the hospital authorities will arrange at their cost installation of the electrical connection and augmentation if required up to the door step of the operating rooms for the facilities undertaken under PPP.
- d. The hospital authorities will develop SOP, management system as well as quality assurance system to be followed by the MRI scan Centre under PPP. An appropriate soft ware package developed by the DoHFW shall be installed by the PSP and all kinds of transactions have to be done by the PSP using that software only so that monitoring at any point of time can be done by the hospital authorities.
- e. The hospital authorities under approval of the DoHFW at Swasthya Bhawan will fix the price of different investigations for the MRI scan centre as described in Section 5a. The rate of each of the investigations will be reviewed by the DoHFW as and when required.
- f. The hospital authorities through RKS shall ensure utilization of the concession fee received from the PSP for safety net for this scheme for the poor and vulnerable population with free services
- g. The hospital authorities shall review the amount of concession fee at the end of each year for revision based on performance
- h. The RKS of the hospital will form a Monitoring Committee to oversee the operational activities of this MRI scan unit under PPP.

4. Role and Responsibilities of the PSP

- a. The PSP shall duly sign the Possession letter (to be incorporated as Schedule in the legal agreement) for the space provided by the hospital authorities for conducting the MRI scan services.
- b. The PSP shall comply with the conditions laid down in Section 3b relating to structural modifications of the space.
- c. Installation of electricity meter in its own name will be undertaken by the PSP as described under Section 3c.
- d. The PSP shall ensure that the concession fee is paid in the account of the RKS of the hospital on quarterly basis within the time frame to be incorporated in the legal agreement.
- e. The PSP shall be responsible at its own cost all operation and management of the MRI scan unit including maintenance of equipments and deployment of required medical, technical and other personnel in accordance with the relevant Clinical Establishment Acts and Norms.
- f. The PSP shall comply with all statutory requirements as applicable under The West Bengal Clinical Establishment Act 1950 and The West Bengal Clinical Establishment Rules 2003 as amended hereafter and other applicable Acts and Laws.
- g. The PSP shall also comply with the fire safety requirements as per West Bengal Fire Services Act, 1950 as amended up to date.
- h. The PSP shall ensure that the MRI scan unit operated by it shall be accessible for teaching and training purposes for undergraduates and postgraduates students as and when required. In addition, if required, the PSP shall ensure installation of multi station monitoring mode for interpretation and review of reports by the competent authority of the Hospital.
- i. The PSP shall ensure that the MRI unit operated by it in this institute will be integrated in the Teleradiology facilities, as and when installation of such facilities is considered by the DoHFW for implementation in this state for the purpose of review and reports as well as for training and teaching purposes for the radio diagnostic system.
- j. The PSP shall ensure that the services would be operational round the clock as specified in Section 8.
- k. The PSP shall comply with the requirements for adherence to pricing policies and reporting system. The PSP shall arrange for submission of all prescribed documents relating to operation and performance of the centre of each calendar month not later than 5th of the next month.
- I. The PSP shall comply with the requirements of furnishing Performance Security as stated under Section 2b4 at the time of signing the legal agreement.

5. Policy on Rates (User Charges) and Free Services

a. Rates (User charges)

- i. The PSP will charge, collect and retain user charges from patients of the Government Hospitals for the cost of specific services for the MRI scan centre at rates provided as Annexure V. With the objective of making the rates affordable for the patients, the rates have been worked out taking into account the existing rates of 1.5 Tesla MRI scan units in different hospitals in the DoHFW under PPP. The rates fixed for M.R.Bangur Hospital are much lower than the existing market rates.
- ii. Rates should be prominently displayed by the PSP in the Hospital where these services are provided.
- iii. The PSP may also extend the services to patients referred by private practitioners/private hospitals and charge, collect and retain user charges at the market rate. However, it is to be noted that patients of the concerned hospital will get priority at all times for use of these facilities.

b. Free Services

- i. The policy of free services shall be applicable to poor and vulnerable sections of the population, BPL category of patients as well as patients eligible for free services as per guidelines of the DoHFW. These patients will be referred by the Director of M.R.BANGUR HOSPITAL or his authorized representative recommending for free services with the required hospital prescription of the concerned patients. Such free services will be provided by the PSP in each month to the eligible patients for up to 20% of the total number of patients¹ who have undergone investigations for MRI in the previous month. For example, if the required investigations have been conducted for a total number of 500 patients in a month, the number of free services shall be extended to (20 % of 500) 100 eligible patients in the following month. The total number of patients for the purpose of calculation will include both the hospital patients as well as patients referred by private practitioners/private hospitals.
- ii. The provision of patients entitled for free tests will be made on a monthly basis and unutilized provision, if any, will not be carried forward to the next month.
- iii. The PSP shall keep relevant record for such free services (e.g photocopy of prescription). The monthly information system shall include necessary details of free services provided during the month and the number of patients entitled for free services in the following month.
- iv. The **proceeds from concession fee** will be utilized for reimbursement of the cost of free services provided by the PSP and the same will be reimbursed by the RKS to the concerned PSP on quarterly basis on submission of prescribed documents. Any excess/deficit for such reimbursement will be adjusted in the subsequent quarters.
- vi Monitoring of implementation of the policy on free services shall be undertaken by the authorized personnel of RKS

¹ The total number of patients includes patients both under the paying and free category of patients who have undergone the investigation/services in the centre under PPP.

6. Monitoring Mechanisms

- a) The competent authority of the Hospital on behalf of RKS shall monitor the dayto-day operational activities of the services undertaken by the PSP.
- b) Performance review will be undertaken by RKS on quarterly basis. Senior Official from DoHFW will be present during Performance Review..
- c) The PSP shall be required to submit prescribed documents including monthly reports in prescribed format to concerned officials
- d) An appropriate soft ware package developed by the DoHFW shall be installed by the PSP and all kinds of transactions have to be done by the PSP using that software only so that monitoring at any point of time can be done by the hospital authorities.

7. Causes for Termination

Any of the following events shall constitute an event of default by the PSPs entitling DoHFW to terminate this agreement:

- a. Failure to commence services in the Hospital within three months of signing the agreement
- b. Failure to comply with the requirement of round the clock services
- c. Collecting charges from the patients in violation of the Policy on User Charges
- d. Failure by the PSP to deliver timely reports on more than five occasions in a month.
- e. Inaccuracy detected in at least three occasions in a period of three months in the diagnostic reports generated in the Centre.
- f. Error detected in more than two occasions in six months in recording the correct entry of the number of patients referred from the concerned hospital as well as by the private practitioners/private hospitals in each month.
- g. Failure to comply with the statutory requirements, Clinical Establishment Acts, Rules and other applicable norms
- h. Criminal indictment of the promoters, member/s of the Board of Directors, chief functionaries, key personnel engaged by the PSP for operation and management of the services.
- i. Engagement of unqualified persons for running of the Services
- j. Use of the allocated space by the PSP for any other purpose other than the approved scheme.
- k. Non-compliance of the approved specification in installation of the 1.5 Tesla MRI scan machine

I. Failure to deposit concession fee by the PSP for a given quarter within due date as per terms of the agreement.

Upon occurrence of any of the defaults, the hospital authorities would follow the procedures of issuing Notice/Show Cause before deciding on termination of the agreement. The decision of the hospital authorities shall be final and M.R.Bangur Hospitalding on the PSP.

8. Duration of services

The PSP shall ensure that the services would be provided round the clock through out the year for **at least 95%** of the time with maximum of 5% time to be spared for maintenance activities of the equipment. The prescribed services will not be interrupted for more than five days in a quarter.

9. Eligibility criteria of applicants and selection process

a. SELECTION COMMITTEE

The process of selection shall be undertaken by a Selection Committee (SC) under the Chairmanship of the Director of M.R.BANGUR HOSPITAL:

b. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA OF THE ORGANIZATION FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

The eligibility criteria for application of intending organizations for consideration of selection of the Organization for operation and management of the Hospital under PPP are provided as under:

- The Organization (Limited Company/Private Limited Company / Partnership or Proprietary Firm / NGO / Trust/ Charitable/Philanthropic) must be registered under appropriate statutory authority of Government of West Bengal / Government of India or under Companies Act
- 2) The Organization has been operating and managing a Hospital / Nursing Home for last three years and above with facilities for MRI scan in the existing facility in any State of India

Or

The Organization has been operating and managing a Diagnostic and investigation Centre for last three years and above and having investigation facilities for MRI scan in the existing facility in any State of India

3) The annual turn over of the Organization (in Rupees) shall be considered for being eligible to apply are as under:

Rs Eight Crore in aggregate of last two financial years ending March 2013 in case the Organization has been running a Hospital or Nursing Home as mentioned under point 2 above

or

Rs Four Crore in aggregate of last two financial years ending March 2013 in case the Organization has been running a Diagnostic and Investigation Centre as mentioned under point 2 above

4) No litigation is pending on date and no penal measures were taken against the applicant under applicable Acts and laws

Applicant failing to fulfill any of the above-mentioned Eligibility Criteria will not be considered for selection. However, the SC may relax one or more of the eligibility criteria except sl no. 4 in case of deserving applicants

c. SELECTION PROCESS

1. Selection process would involve short-listing of applicants based on marks scored by the applicants on each of the criteria as under. Physical inspection at the facilities of the applicants with prior intimation may be undertaken by SC or members authorized by SC for gathering information relating to short listing of applicants for further processing for selection.
